I was very angry at this – we prayed immediately against this ‘curse’. We have continued to pray with Dorah – right until the day before the baby was born – a few weeks overdue (the baby was due in August). We prayed for God to bring the child from darkness in the light, and gave thanks for the new life. Nkosi was born the day after on the floor of Dorah’s shack. She said this child is God’s child – that is why I have named him Nkosi (King) because he belongs to the King of Kings Jesus! Both mother and child are doing well. I am so grateful to God for answering our prayers; I was in tears as I dedicated Nkosi to God.
