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Report of the Independent Examiner to the Members of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) ofChrist Church Oakworth with St John's Newsholmefor the year ended 31st December 2023

I report on the accounts of the church for the year ended 31 December 2023 which are set out on pages 2 to3.

Respective responsibilities of the PCC and the examiner

As members of the PCC you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The PCC members consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. It is my responsibility to:-

- Examine the accounts (under section 145 of the 2011 Act);
- To follow the procedures laid down in the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners (under section 145(5) (b) of the 2011 Act); and
- To state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of this report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commission. That examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the PCC and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from you as PCC members concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a "true and fair view" and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.

Independent examiner's statement

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Notes to the Financial Statements

for the year ended 31st December 2023

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation

The accounts of the PCC have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts & Payments basis.

The accounts include all transactions, assets and liabilities for which the PCC is responsible in law. They do not include the accounts of church groups that owe their main affiliation to another body nor those that are informal gatherings of church members.

Fixed Assets

Consecrated and beneficed property of any kind is excluded from the statement of assets and liabilities in accordance with section 10 (2) (a) and (c) of the Charities Act 2011.

Moveable church furnishings held by the Vicar and Churchwardens on special trust for the PCC, and which require a facility for disposal, are accounted as inalienable property unless consecrated. They are listed in the church's inventory which can be inspected at any reasonable time. For alienable property acquired prior to 2000, there is insufficient cost information available and therefore such assets are not valued in the accounts. Items acquired since 1 January 2000 have been capitalised and depreciated over their currently anticipated useful economic life on a straight-line basis.

All expenditure incurred in the year on consecrated or beneficed buildings comprising individual items under $\pounds 1,000$ or on the repair of moveable church furnishings acquired before 1st January 2001 are written off.

Furniture and equipment used within the church premises is depreciated in the statement of assets and liabilities on a straight-line basis over 10 years.

Individual items of equipment with a purchase price of £100 or less are not included in the statement of assets and liabilities.

Funds

Unrestricted funds are incoming resources receivable or generated for the objects of the PCC without further specified purposes and are available as general funds, unless designated for a specific purpose as determined by the PCC.

Restricted funds are to be used for specific purposes. Income and expenditure which meet these criteria are charged to those funds. Any balance remaining unspent at the end of the year must be carried forward as a balance on that fund.

Endowed funds comprise a generous bequest of $\pounds 10,000$ received in 2009 from the estate of Michael Wright, a member of St James Church Cross Roads-cum-Lees but a long time friend of this Christ Church. The bequest is restricted in that only the interest can be used to support the maintenance of the churchyard where his ashes are now interred in the family grave.
